Introduction to VPN Services

Information Technology (IT) services at Child Advocates provides remote access services through SSL VPN, and thus offering secure access to organization's network.

There are two ways to connect to the organization's network using SSL VPN.

Solution I: SSL VPN Client

Step 1: Download the VPN client tool and save it to the desktop.

Windows: URL: <u>http://www.childadvocates.org/assets/sslvpnclient.exe</u>

Mac OSX/Linux URL: <u>http://www.childadvocates.org/assets/sslvpnclients-all.zip</u>

Step 2:

For Windows XP, double-click SSLVPNClient.exe and install the application.

For Windows Vista/7, right-click SSLVPNClient.exe and click on Run as administrator (as shown below).

Follow the installation instructions and click Finish once done.

Step 3: Go to Start \rightarrow All Programs \rightarrow FortiClient \rightarrow FortiClient SSL VPN to launch the program.

On the screen, enter the following details:

Server Address: vpn.childadvocates.org Username: <username> Password: <password>, and click Connect.

Windows XP

Launch Remote Desktop Connection (Start \rightarrow Programs \rightarrow Accessories \rightarrow Communications \rightarrow Remote Desktop Connection) and enter **vm-remote02.cai.local**, as shown below and click 'Connect'.

Windows 7

Launch Remote Desktop Connection (Start \rightarrow All Programs \rightarrow Accessories \rightarrow Remote Desktop Connection) and enter **vm-remote02.cai.local**, as shown below and click 'Connect'.
